Section 4: First aid measures

4.1 Description of first aid measures

Skin contact: wash the contaminated skin thoroughly with plenty of water and soap, consult a doctor, if disturbing symptoms occur.

<u>Eye contact</u>: consult a doctor if disturbing symptoms appear, protect non-irritated eye, remove contact lenses. Rinse contaminated eyes with copious amount of water for a few minutes. Avoid strong stream of water – risk of damage of the cornea.

Ingestion: exposure by this route does not usually occur.

Inhalation: consult a doctor if disturbing symptoms appear. Move the victim to fresh air. Keep victim warm and calm.

4.2 Most important symptoms and effects, both acute and delayed

In case of a proper use, negative effects of exposure are not expected.

4.3 Indication of any immediate medical attention and special treatment needed

Physician makes a decision regarding further medical treatment after thoroughly examination of the injured. Symptomatic treatment.

Section 5: Firefighting measures

5.1 Extinguishing media

<u>Suitable extinguishing media</u>: CO₂, extinguishing powder, extinguishing foam resistant to alcohols, water spray. <u>Unsuitable extinguishing media</u>: water jet – risk of propagation of the flame.

5.2 Special hazards arising from the substance or mixture

During combustion harmful fumes consisting of carbon oxides and other unidentified products of thermal decomposition may be produced. Do not inhale combustion products, it may cause health risk.

5.3 Advice for firefighters

Personal protection typical in case of fire. Do not stay in the fire zone without self-contained breathing apparatus and protective clothing resistant to chemicals. In case of fire cool endangered containers with water fog from safe distance. Collect used extinguishing media.

Personal precautions, protective equipment and emergency procedures

7.1 Precautions for safe handling
